1) Dr Pepper Tuition Giveaway Scholarship - \$100,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: October 18, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) The contest is open to all students of the freshman, sophomore, junior and senior classes (Grades 9 - 12) in the public, parochial, private and home schools within the jurisdiction of the sponsoring state society or district.

4) Maryknoll Scholarship - \$1,000 - 6 Awards (Deadline: November 10, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Students in grades 6–8 (Division I) and grades 9–12 (Division II) qualify. Entries must be written in English, only one entry per student. Children of Maryknoll employees, associates and affiliates are not eligible.

Requirements:

- applicant must either live with the parent outlined above or live at another residence within the area in which that parent is employed
- applicant must be a graduating senior planning to attend college
- applicant must have 3.0 GPA

AXA Achievement Scholarship
