

## 2017-2018 New Bremen Elementary/Middle School Supply List

### Kindergarten

8 **LARGE** Elmer's glue sticks (purple glue color works best)  
1 Elmer's school glue  
2 Yellow #2 Pencils (no character pencils, they don't sharpen well)  
1 Large eraser  
2 Dry Erase Markers (black, thin)  
1 Fiskar's (or similar brand) scissors for kids (pointed tip, ages 5+)  
1 Pocket Folder (sturdy with pockets on the bottom – plastic holds up best)  
A Backpack (large enough to hold your folder without bending it)  
1 Box of tissues  
\$1.00 for Crayon Box (given at orientation)  
\$1.00 for a Letter Pocket (given at orientation)  
4 packs of 24 Crayola crayons (write your child's initials on each crayon, toward the bottom)  
1 box of 10 Classic Fine tip Crayola markers  
Please write your child's name on everything

### First Grade

2 pocket folders (pockets on the bottom)  
Eraser  
Crayons - no more than 24 (no washable)  
4 1/2" pointed scissors  
School glue - white glue only (no gel and no washable)  
Large box of Kleenex  
Plastic school box (8" x 5")  
Book bag  
3 Sharpened pencils - #2 lead yellow wood ones  
4 dry erase markers (no washable)  
Napkins or extra box of Kleenex  
1 box of Ziploc bags (sandwich, gallon)  
3 - 1 oz. Glue sticks  
1 set of watercolor paints  
Crayola 10 Count Classic Broad Line Markers  
Headphones

### Second Grade

2 Large erasers  
Highlighter  
8 - number 2 pencils (can be mechanical)  
Large pencil bag (11" by 7" with zipper closure) –Those with a clear plastic window usually get holes in them quickly. Cloth bags are best (like canvas)  
Elmer's white glue (4 ounces, no washable, gel or no-run)  
4 glue sticks (non-washable)  
Crayons (box of 24) – Regular colors (non-washable)  
3 - pocket folders  
Pointed scissors  
4 - Dry erase low odor markers  
1 package twistable colored pencils  
1 – 5 Subject Notebook (wide-ruled)  
Girls – 1 Box of tissues – family size please  
Boys – Box of Quart-sized Ziploc baggies  
\$1.25 for plastic Parent-School Communication folder  
Backpacks - No Back Packs with wheels.  
Ear buds/headphones  
NO TRAPPER KEEPERS  
No Ink Pens

### Third Grade

1 set of 8 washable fine tip markers  
4 black dry erase markers  
1 - 10 1/2" x 8" wide ruled, 70 sheet spiral notebook  
1 pocket folder with brads  
1 folder (no brads)  
2 Boxes of Kleenex, regular/large size  
Pointed Scissors  
1 pack of Red Grading Pens or Pencils  
Crayons - no larger than 24 - Please no washable  
1 package #2 Pencils (labeled with name)  
1 Large Eraser  
Elmer's White Glue (no washable or gel)  
2 large glue sticks (non-washable)  
Multiplication flashcards (by October 1)  
Ear buds/headphones (must fit in sandwich baggie)  
\$3 for a pencil box – enclose in sealed envelope with your student's name on it (given at Meet the Teacher Night)

### Fourth Grade

8 to 12 pack of colored pencils  
8 to 10 pack of broad tip markers

5-10 #2 lead pencils, 1 eraser  
Small container for supplies  
(boxes that are approximately 8 x 5 fit nicely in desk)  
1" binder 3 ring binder for Social Studies  
1 – one subject spiral notebook  
2 – regular pocket folders  
6 dry erase markers  
2 large boxes of tissues  
Ear buds/headphones
