Semester Average Calculation

A student's semester average will be calculated using the following:

- 1st Nine Weeks Grade 40%
- 2nd Nine Weeks Grade 40%
- Semester Exam 20%

Example: Joe Smith earns a 82% during the first 9 weeks, an 89% during the second 9 weeks, and scores a 94% on the exam. Here is how his semester average would be calculated:

$$82 \times 0.4 = 32.8$$

$$89 \times 0.4 = 35.6$$

$$94 \times 0.2 = 18.8$$

$$32.8 + 35.6 + 18.8 = 87.2$$

87.2% is Joe Smith's semester average which is a B

Grade Point Average

Students Grade Point Average (GPA) will be calculated using their semester average, not their nine weeks average. The semester average for classes without an exam will be calculated by taking 50% of each 9 weeks grade to find the average.
