- High School band combined with New Knoxville and Minster at the Minster game. It was good for our kids to see how other bands operated, and it was a nice performance at halftime.
- The Cheese and Sausage sale ran from September 3 through the 20th. The band students sold over \$24,000 worth of products, which is down from last year. The fifth grade band was the winning class so they will have a doughnut party this Friday.
- On September 24th, I took eight of my eighth grade band students, and we put together a presentation for Capabilities, the adult MRDD center on 66A. The kids all spoke about their instruments, gave a little demonstration, and then played together as a small ensemble. The people there were very nice and very appreciative. Afterward I took the kids out to lunch at China 88.
- The high school band has been busy working on the competition show, as well as the Rock show for last week's Homecoming Game. The fifth grade band is up to five notes now. The other middle school bands have been preparing Christmas music, and the eighth grade is also preparing for Veterans' Day.
- Next week we will be performing in Kettering. We are the second band out of 14. We are scheduled to perform at 6:00. There are five C bands. An itinerary will be sent home as soon as I get the schedule, and work with Mrs. Ruckman, as she is having her dress rehearsal next Saturday also.

- We are currently at 21 bands, and I am not taking any more.
