SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT



The new K-6 elementary building will be ready to start the 2020-2021 school year. The contractors are finishing up installation of classroom furnishings and building technology this week. We will have some construction work on the exterior of the building and site work that needs to be completed after school begins. This work should not impact daily school operations and the safety of our students.

The district continues to monitor the pandemic situation with COVID-19. New information and guidance changes weekly based on local and State data. We will continue to use One Call Now, social media, and the district website to provide the most up-to-date information. If you have any questions, feel free to email or call the school.

School Hours

School hours for this upcoming year have been adjusted to optimize traffic flow at the new facility.

Elementary (K-6) 8:15 am – 3:05 pm High School (7-12) 8:20 am – 3:10 pm

Morning and After School Traffic Flow

*A color coded map of the campus is available on the district website depicting student, parent, and bus traffic flow.

Parents planning to drop students off at school this year will need to enter the main entrance off of Monroe Street (SR 274) and follow the drive along the front of the high school building. The drive is “one way” with the curbside lane being designated as the drop off zone. Students may be dropped off in front of the high school or elementary. We are asking parents **not** to enter the school campus through the vacated section of Cardinal Street as this section will be used as the exit for parent drop off. Parents picking up students at the end of the school day should use the same drive as morning drop off in front of the school. We will allow parents to temporarily wait curbside in the vehicle to pick up students.

All students driving to school will need to enter the rear parking lot from Kettler Road. Students should park on the west side of the center parking lot islands closest to the athletic stadium. The parking area between the islands closest to the school is designated as staff parking.

Students who walk or ride a bike to school should use the sidewalk on the north side of the athletic stadium or the sidewalk along Monroe Street to access school grounds. Access to the rear parking lot will be restricted by a gate before and after school to allow students to cross the drive safely.

*All traffic entering and exiting school grounds during the day should use the main entrance off of Monroe Street (SR 274). The gate access to the rear parking will be open while school is in session.

OneView Parent Portal

Starting this year, New Bremen Schools will be utilizing a new online parent portal, called OneView. While we are just starting to use OneView in a limited capacity, our goal is to eventually create a single place that parents can go online to provide us with information for their children.

To start this year, the OneView Portal is where you will go to complete our annual student forms that previously would have been completed and turned in on paper the first week of school. The forms that you will complete online will include:

- **Emergency Medical Form**
- **Student Handbook**
- **Anti-Bullying Policy**
- **Student Drug Testing Policy (if applicable)**
- **Internet Safety and Acceptable Use Policy**
- **Chromebook Handbook (if applicable)**
- **OneCall Now Forms**
- **Free & Reduced Lunch Forms (if applicable)**

One nice feature of the OneView Portal is that every year after this first year, your child's current information will already be loaded in the system and you will only have to take the time to update us with any changes.

All parents will be receiving a letter in the mail soon with instructions on how to register with OneView and complete these forms. We will be asking that all forms be completed before school actually starts so that this task does not have to be completed the first week of school.



Vision screenings will be administered at the beginning of the school year to all children in kindergarten, first, third, fifth, seventh, ninth and eleventh grade as required by state law. As time allows, students in grades second, fourth, and sixth grades will also be done.

Young children with vision problems do not know the way that they see the world is not the way they should be seeing it! Without early detection and treatment, children's vision problems can lead to permanent vision loss and learning difficulties.

Vision screening will consist of distance visual acuity – ability to see objects far away, for all students, binocular vision – how well you child's eyes work together for grades kindergarten and first, and color vision for kindergarten boys.

If your child does not pass the vision screening, the school nurse will send a letter to share the results and may make a recommendation for further evaluation by an eye care specialist. If you child is under the care of an eye specialist and has had a recent exam, turn in a dated statement from the Doctor and your child will not require the eye screening.

2020-2021 New Bremen Schools Food Service

Dear Cardinal Parents/Guardians:

Welcome back to a new school year!

The Food Service Staff is looking forward to serving your children safe, nutritious, great-tasting meals that support them in and outside the classroom. We are striving to provide our students outstanding quality meals that meet the Federal and State Requirements.

This year will be a little different in regards to Covid-19, but we are committed to doing our very best for your children.



What will your Student's Lunch include?

Lunch includes a meat/meat alternative, bread/grain, fruit, vegetable and milk.

Each meal depending on age group must contain a certain number of calories, fat, sodium, fruits, vegetable and fluid milk.

All juice served is 100% fruit juice with no added sugar.

All milk served is 1%.

All grain products contain at least 51% whole grains.

All items are oven baked, we do not fry anything.

We do participate in offer vs. serve lunches. That means we offer all 5 of the components and the students can take or decline as they wish, but must choose a minimum of three and can take up to 5. **One of the components chosen MUST be a fruit or vegetable.**

Some menu items may include more than one component; for example, a hamburger is both the meat/meat alternate and the grain.

How do I pay for school meals?

You can pay by cash, check or through your account on our automated system.

Cash or check payments must be placed in the yellow Cafeteria deposit envelope with your child's full name and grade on it. These envelopes can be found at the school office. Payments can be sent to the Elementary or High School office. If you are paying by check, make checks out to New Bremen Schools. **PAYMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE CAFETERIA.**

We have a great **automated system** that easily allows parents to set up their student's account. Visit the school website at www.newbremenschools.org. Click on the "Lunch Menus" link, listed under the "Parents" heading. Click on the Online Lunch Payment Center link. If this is your first time attempting to log in, you must first create an account. You can use this account to make a payment, set up automatic payments, set up notifications regarding account balances, check balances and to add limits to a child's account such as, "lunch only" or "no extra's, etc." **Limits/restrictions need to be updated every school year.**

Free & Reduced Priced Lunches

- ◆ Applications for Free/Reduced lunches **MUST** be completed online at www.lunchapplication.com
- ◆ A **NEW** application **MUST BE SUBMITTED EACH** school year.

LUNCH ROOM CHANGES

There will be 2 lines during lunch service.

Gold Line - The Gold line will be the regular lunch which will be offered to K-12. This will be located in the new serving line area.

Crimson Line - The Crimson line will be a Salad Bar/Hot Bar. This line will be for 5th-12th grade. Self-serve items are **NOT** allowed at this time. This line will be located where the original high school line was located.

Alternate meal items will only be offered to K-4 since 5-12 will have another option.

Tri Star students will have the option of picking up a to go lunch from either menu. These lunches must be pre-ordered in their 1st period class.

Students **MUST** use the hand sanitizer upon entering the lunch line and follow social distancing. We will be using disposable trays and utensils.

The Breakfast A la Carte will not be offered this year. Lunch A la Carte will be available.

Lunch and School Fees Payment

Parents can **add money** to their child's meal account, see cafeteria **purchase history**, and pay for all **school related fees** securely **online** from a computer, tablet or smartphone! The K12PaymentCenter Mobile App is now available for iOS and Android devices. Download the app now on the Apple App Store and Google Play!

New for this year, parents may pay for school fees online through the K12 Payment Center. School fees will be assessed to students the first week of October, at which time you can view your child's fees for the school year.

With **K12PaymentCenter** the chances of lunch money and school fee payments getting lost or stolen significantly decreases. Plus, you save time not having to come into school to make payments! You can even schedule **recurring payments**, set up **notifications**, and **transfer meal funds**. It will also save your **payment history** so you can refer back at any time. You will have access to your child's account 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

How Do You Get Started? It's simple!

- Go to www.k12paymentcenter.com in your web browser
- First time users click "Sign Up" then select your state and district from the drop-down lists
- Fill in your information to set up the account
- Click "Manage Students" to add your student(s) with their last name and student ID number
- Make a payment to your students' accounts with your credit/debit card or electronic check
 - ◆ \$1.95 convenience fee for credit/debit card payments up to \$100
 - ◆ 2.99% convenience fee for credit/debit payments over \$100
 - ◆ \$0.95 convenience fee for e-Check payments. To set up e-Check payments, follow these instructions:
 - Click **Manage Wallet** on the left menu
 - Under the Cards option you will see a **Banks** option
 - Click the orange **Add Bank Account** button and follow the prompts to securely add your bank
 - Once the bank account is saved you will be able to select it as a payment option in the **Select a Wallet drop down** at the checkout screen.
 - *If an eCheck payment is made and there are insufficient funds in your checking account, the payment will be reversed, and the district may apply an insufficient funds charge to you.*
- Parents can also deposit money into their child's lunch account by sending cash or checks to the school, either by mail or with your child. Please make checks payable to the New Bremen Schools. Once you are made aware of the PIN number, please include that with your payment.

CAFETERIA INFORMATION

Lunch prices for students remained the same as last year. A lunch for grades K-6 is \$2.90 per day or \$14.50 per week. Lunches for grades 7-12 are \$2.95 per day or \$14.75 per week. The price for a carton of milk will be 40 cents. Adult meal prices are \$3.25 per meal.

A student will not be denied a lunch if their account balance is negative. We will allow each account a "charge" of \$20.00 for menu lunches. After the \$20.00 amount is exceeded, the student will be supplied an alternate sandwich lunch.

Parents can now apply online for their student to receive free or reduced price school meals. Applications will be sent from a secure website directly to New Bremen Schools. LunchApplication.com has been designed to make it easy for parents to know exactly what information they need to provide and to guide them through the process.

Once an application has been received, the district office will determine eligibility and send a letter with the results. Or, parents can create an account on LunchApplication.com and results will be received via email.

To apply, simply go to LunchApplication.com and click "Apply Now."

All students will access their accounts in the same way, so students qualified for free or reduced lunch cannot be identified by anyone other than the food service director. A parent may choose to put money into the student's account for *a la carte* use.

If your child has a food allergy, please contact our Cafeteria Manager, Mary Williams. An alert message will be added to your child's account so that we may caution your student from purchasing foods containing potential allergens.

STUDENT ABSENCE AND TARDINESS

Parents of student in grade Kg. thru 12 who will be absent from school or will be arriving late are asked to call 419-629-8606 each morning and follow the prompt for attendance, or an email can be sent to attendance@newbremenschools.org.

In accordance with the Ohio Missing Children Act, the school must account for all students with 2 hours from the start of school. At approximately 9:45 a.m., an automated call will be made to the parents that we have not received notice from, to inform them that their son or daughter is not at school. A person to person call will be made sooner if possible to make parents aware of an unreported absence. Doctor notes are encouraged when applicable. Notes dated and signed by the parents are also acceptable prior to an absence.

STUDENT DRESS CODE REMINDER

The Student Dress Code for the upcoming year will be the same as last year including that shorts of appropriate length may be worn by students K-6 from April through October and students in grades 7-12 year-round.

The following are areas listed in the Dress Code which have caused some concern in past years resulting in violations being noted:

- a. Shirts with sleeves removed or leaving the armpits exposed are unacceptable.
b. Bare midriiffs or torsos are unacceptable.
c. Untied shoes are unacceptable.
d. Dresses, skirts, and shorts are to be of reasonable length and in good taste. Cheer shorts, biker shorts, and tights/yoga pants without an appropriate length top are unacceptable.
e. Hair must be clean and out of the eyes.

A copy of the complete Student Dress Code is printed in the 2020-2021 Student Handbook section of your student planner which will be distributed to students on the first day of school.

SCHOOL DELAYS AND CANCELLATIONS

Whenever the health or safety of students may be in jeopardy due to weather conditions, contagious illnesses, or utility problems, the New Bremen Local Schools may need to delay or close school for the day. Announcements will be made as early as possible, however, there are always unpredictable situations which could cause a late announcement. Students and parents are requested not to call the school or the homes of school personnel for information concerning a delay or cancellation. The information will be on one of the following radio stations, on TV Channel 2 or 7 or WLIO Channel 35 out of Lima, and/or you will be notified by the school's automated notification system.

STUDENTS IN PHOTOGRAPHS

Often throughout the course of the school year, students could be photographed in individual or class activities for newsletter, newspaper, website, or other school publication.

Unless the Principal of the building is notified in writing, students are assumed to have given permission for New Bremen to use their picture in connection with school or school-related activities and to put the pictures to any legitimate use without limitation, reservation, or compensation.

CALCULATOR REQUIREMENT

Students that will be taking Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Pre-Calculus/Trigonometry, Foundations of College Math, or AP Calculus will be required to purchase a **TI-83 Plus** or **TI-84 Plus Calculator**. This is just a reminder to purchase one before the start of the school year.

MEDICATION POLICY

According to the Ohio Revised Code, there must be a written note signed before a drug can be administered to a student. Therefore, please provide the School Nurse's Office a statement by the prescribing physician that includes the following information:

- a. Name and address of the pupil
- b. School and class of the pupil
- c. The name, dosage, and time the drug is to be administered
- d. The dates when the administering should begin and end
- e. The physicians phone number and any other special instructions

Please be reminded that no medication can be administered without these signed statements on file beginning with the first day of medication.

STUDENT RECORDS NOTIFICATION

The New Bremen Local Schools shall annually notify parents and eligible students currently enrolled of their rights under state and federal law. Those rights pertaining to student records include the right:

- a. To inspect and review the student's education records
- b. To request the amendment of the student's education records to ensure that they are not inaccurate, misleading, or otherwise in violation of the student's privacy or other rights

c. Be aware that the intent of the School District to limit disclosure of information contained in a student's education records, except:

- 1. By prior written consent of the parent or eligible student
- 2. As directory information (age, sex, height, etc.)
- 3. Under certain limited circumstances as permitted by law, including military recruiters. Under the provisions of the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB), names and addresses of students in grades 10 through 12 must be released to an armed forces recruiting officer unless a parent, or a student age 18 or older, submits a written request not to release the information.

d. Parents and/or students in secondary school may request in writing that records be released without their prior written consent

e. To file a complaint with the Department of Education if the School District violates section of this regulation (FERPA)

A complete copy of the Student's Record Policy is available by contacting the Building Principal's Office or the Superintendent's Office. In accordance with federal law, the New Bremen Schools will provide arrangements for translations of this notice to non-English speaking parents in their native language if requested.

ATHLETIC AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

Students who participate in athletics and extracurricular activities are expected to represent the New Bremen Schools and community with dignity, honor, and respect. Realizing that students who represent our school in athletics and extracurricular activities should be in good academic standing, the following minimum academic eligibility requirements shall be in effect for students in grades 7 - 12 to become and/or maintain eligibility for the next nine weeks:

Students in Grades 7-8

- 1. Students must have earned at least a 1.5 Grade Point Average (GPA) the previous nine-week grading period.
- 2. All students in grades 7-8 who wish to participate in interscholastic athletics must pass five courses in the preceding 9 week grading period.

Students in Grades 9-12

- 1. Students must pass academic subjects in the preceding 9 week grading period that earn a minimum of five credits per year which count toward graduation.
- 2. Students cannot fail more than one (1) subject at the end of the 9 week grading period and must have at least a 1.5 Grade Point Average (GPA) to maintain eligibility for the next nine weeks.



ATHLETIC SEASON



The 2020 Cardinal Football Team will open the regular season with a home game against Minster on Friday, August 28. All varsity football games will be at **7:00 PM** this year. The Lady Cardinal Volleyball Team will play their first game of the season with an away game on Tuesday, August 25 against Russia.

Season Passes will not be sold this year due to possible capacity restrictions at games. More information about ticket sales will be released when more guidance is provided to us by OHSAA.
