The New Bremen School District consists of one elementary/middle school and one high school. The elementary services grades K-5, the middle school services grades 6-8, and the high school grades 9-12. The district was given a "A" in value-added and graduation for the 2017-2018 school year. All schools in the New Bremen School District continually strive to attain accelerated academic goals in order to further the success of the students. When compared to other school districts, New Bremen Local Schools perform at a competitive academic level in all academic areas.

Community

New Bremen, Ohio, a village of 3,076 people, is located in West Central Ohio. Founded in 1833 along the Miami-Erie Canal, the New Bremen community offers a wholesome, family atmosphere that is an ideal place for families and business.

Major businesses in New Bremen include: Crown Equipment Corporation, Safeway Packaging, Nupco Incorporated, New Bremen Machine and Tool, Auglaize Mercer YMCA, Speedway Lanes, Elmwood Centers Incorporated, and Kinninger Production Welding.

Approximately 30% of the adult residents hold a bachelor's degree or higher, and the median household income is \$66,667. The unemployment rate for Auglaize County is 3.2%.
