Congratulations to you and your fine musicians for earning a superior rating at your district event and advancing to Northwest Region State Finals. We here at Findlay have been working hard to insure an enjoyable experience for all.

We have enclosed several items for your use in preparing for this event:

- 1) Participating Ensembles/Performance Sites/Time Schedule/Homerooms
- 2) Percussion List
- 3) Directions to Findlay High School
- 4) Maps of Findlay High School

Please plan to arrive one hour prior to your scheduled performance time. You will be met by your guide at the unload area upon your arrival. Directors will then check in at contest headquarters. *Please do not allow students to leave the busses until you have checked-in.*

After unloading, your guide will take you and your students to your assigned homeroom. Please remind your students about OMEA guidelines regarding proper treatment and utilization of homerooms (no food or drink, playing, vandalism, etc. – we do ask that the homeroom be used for storage only and not a hangout location) – our teachers have had some issues this year with other events using rooms (not our OMEA event) with guest students leaving notes in teacher desks/student desks and I would like to ensure they have a good impression of this event.

Your guide will meet you at your homeroom 5 minutes before your scheduled warm-up time to escort you to your warm-up room. Set-up crews and percussionists for bands will be taken to the performance area 10 minutes before the end of the designated warm-up time. After your performance your guide will escort you to the sight-reading room. Please remind your students to tell family and friends that only performers and directors are permitted in the sight-reading area. Following your sight-reading experience you will be escorted back to your homeroom to gather your properties and to put the room back to the condition in which it was found. You will not receive your ratings until your homeroom is checked and cleared. Ratings will be posted in the cafeteria where you will also find a full selection of delicious concessions offered by the Findlay Music Boosters. No food or drink is permitted anywhere except the cafeteria.

Please reacquaint yourselves with the OMEA Rules and Regulations. Remind students to share the following with friends and family:

Under no circumstances are audio/video recordings or pictures of any kind to be made in a warm up room, performance area, or sight reading room at any time. Cell phones, pagers and other electronic devices are to be turned off in all performance areas. Directors must inform their students, parents, and friends of participants that failure to comply may result in consequences up to and including disqualification.

Percussion List

Percussion equipment provided for performance stages and sight-reading will include:

bass drum, timpani, bells, xylophone, vibes (no motor), marimba, & chimes

Each band is responsible for their own mallets and any instrument not listed above.

If you choose to bring your own instruments in lieu of those that we have provided they may be unloaded at the front of the high school and stored in the area between the auditorium and the cafeteria.

Directions to Findlay High School

From the **NORTH** (via I-75): Take I-75 south to Exit 159 (SR 224).

Turn east (left) on to Trenton Avenue.

Turn south (right) on to Broad Avenue (BP, Speedway, & Subway).

Turn west (right) into bus lane in front of FHS.

From the **SOUTH** (via I-75): Take I-75 north to Exit 159 (SR 224).

Turn east (right) on to Trenton Avenue.

Turn south (right) on to Broad Avenue (BP, Speedway, & Subway).

Turn west (right) into bus lane in front of FHS.

From the **EAST** (via SR 12): Take SR 12 west to Bright Road.

Turn north (right) on to Bright Road.
Turn west (left) on to Melrose Avenue.
Turn south (left) on to Main Street.
Turn west (right) on to Trenton Avenue.

Turn south (left) on to Broad Avenue (BP, Speedway, & Subway).

Turn west (right) into bus lane in front of FHS.

From the **EAST** (via US 224): Take US 224 west to Broad Avenue.

Turn south (left) on to Broad Avenue (BP, Speedway, & Subway).

Turn west (right) into bus lane in front of FHS.

From the **WEST** (via SR 12): Take SR 12 east to I-75 north.

Take I-75 north to Exit 159 (SR 224). Turn east (right) on to Trenton Avenue.

Turn south (right) on to Broad Avenue (BP, Speedway, & Subway).

Turn west (right) into bus lane in front of FHS.

From the **WEST** (via SR 224): Take US 224 east to Broad Avenue.

Turn south (right) on to Broad Avenue (BP, Speedway, & Subway).

Turn west (right) into bus lane in front of FHS.

From the **SOUTH / SW** (via SR 15): Take SR 15 north to I-75 north.

Take I-75 north to Exit 159 (SR 224). Turn east (right) on to Trenton Avenue.

Turn south (right) on to Broad Avenue (BP, Speedway, & Subway).

Turn west (right) into bus lane in front of FHS.

All busses and equipment vehicles will unload in the bus lane in front of FHS. Equipment vehicles should pull in first and proceed to the wheelchair ramp for unloading.

^{***}The numbers in front of the percussion parts indicate the number of PERFORMERS that are needed. This should help in your preparation for sight-reading.

Directors are encouraged NOT to bring their own large percussion instruments into the SR room. SR adjudicators feel this causes the schedule to get behind. Please use the equipment provided in the room. Directors are reminded they are to bring their own sticks, mallets, and beaters.
